



CBSEWORKSHOPS



GURUDAKSHATA PROGRAMME

An Induction Training Programme by CBSE. The Guru Dakshta Program aims to equip principals and teachers of newly affiliated schools with the CBSE system as well as existing CBSE-affiliated schools with the abilities and resources needed to be successful in their roles.

The Induction Training Programme introduces teachers and school heads to the structure, policies, and guidelines of all the constituent departments and units of CBSE, including Training, Examination, Affiliation, Academics, Skill Education, IT, Professional Examination, CTET, CoEs, and ROs. The Guru Dakshta Program includes eight sessions of 90 minutes each, deliberating on the functioning of these departments and units, which serve as a foundation for their competency building and growth in their roles in schools.

CBP WORKSHOP ON GENDER SENSITIVITY

A Capacity Building Programme on Gender Sensitivity was organized by teachers of St. Xavier's High School, GNW. The workshop was held on , 4 th March, 2025 from 8.30 am to 4.30 pm in the school. The two Resource Persons for the Workshop were Ms. Pooja Bose, Principal, Pacific School and Mrs. Renu Sharma, Director Principal, Indirapuram Public School.

Mrs. Kirti Tandon, Principal at St. Xavier's High School,inaugurated the session and welcomed both the Resource Persons from CBSE. The session began with Ms Bose explaining the difference between the two commonly misunderstood terms - Gender and Sex. She discussed the role of power in gender relationships and instructed the teachers to not use any gender sensitive language in the classroom. She was of the opinion that the books prescribed in the curriculum must include topics on gender sensitivity and the same should be an integral part of the syllabus. She also suggested that study material on Gender Sensitivity should be made available to the students and teachers. She urged the teachers to establish a congenial environment in the classroom and encourage discussions with students on topics relating to sex and gender.

HAPPY CLASSROOMS- A CAPACITY BUILDING WORKSHOP

St. Xavier's High School hosted a capacity Building Workshop for its teachers and those from the surrounding schools on 'Happy Classrooms'. 


